

Class Dojo is going to be our main communication platform that will be used throughout the year.

I will be checking my class dojo before school starts, as well as after school. Please turn your Class Dojo notifications on. I'd also kindly ask that you move the app to the main screen on your phone. That way, if I do try to reach you, you'll be able to see the little red notification symbol on your app.

Students will also have a "Take Home Folder". This is where they will keep their Home Reading Chart. Please send the folder to school every day, as this is where we will safely put things that can be kept at home, or things that need to be filled out and returned to school.
